Encyclopaedia of Islam



- 1890 - Encyclopaedia of Islam 1st edition in English, French and German (EI1 is almost entirely written by western scholars)
- 1954 - Encyclopaedia of Islam, Second Edition / Encyclopédie de l'Islam (EI2 includes more authors with a muslim background / part of the muslim community)
- 2007 - Encyclopaedia of Islam, THREE (EI3 has an intergrated approach, with authors from different academic backgrounds)

Index Islamicus is THE international classified bibliography of publications in European languages on all aspects of Islam and the Muslim world from 1906 onwards until present day.




