Introduction to OSO New Modules



New modules will launch 29th October 2020

Due to the accelerated need to get as much of our publishing digitized, these 600+ backlist titles will be added as **PDF + metadata-only** at launch. This means each book will be:

- Searchable alongside all the books on OSO and UPSO
- Have abstracts and keywords
- Only be accessed by downloading print-replica PDFs

Full-text XML will be captured following launch, provisionally planned to start being added in February/March 2021.




