








Commitment to Quality Publisher comparison


Of OUP's journals with an Impact Factor, over 20% of our journals are ranked in the Top 10% of their subject category, and over 45% are in the top 25%





OUP Journals Value – Cost per Citation (\$)







Introduction to OSO New Modules



Originated from the 30 day Challenge Initiative organized by the Digital Product Acceleration Programme (DPAP) which aimed to dramatically accelerate our digitisation of books in response to COVID-19 (condensing 3-5 years of work)

Programme identified subject areas based on publishing lists, customer interest, sales feedback, and potential revenue

Created a list of books that needed to be added to OSO before the OxAc migration which fell in to seven modules – some new to OSO but not UPSO, and some completely new to the platform

Introduction to OSO New Modules



New modules will launch 29th October 2020

Due to the accelerated need to get as much of our publishing digitized, these 600+ backlist titles will be added as **PDF + metadata-only** at launch. This means each book will be:

- Searchable alongside all the books on OSO and UPSO
- Have abstracts and keywords
- Only be accessed by downloading print-replica PDFs

Full-text XML will be captured following launch, provisionally planned to start being added in February/March 2021. We will communicate further details as they become available.
