What is the Springer Book Archive?


- 120,000 eBooks Content dating from 1842-2004
- Available as one-off purchase with continuous access in German and English packages, priced depending on institution size
- Titles are digitized to high standards
- (OCLC) MARC records available at no extra charge

Bookmetrix pulls together information about the attention paid to, use of and impact of books


Books benefit hugely from new ways of looking at attention & impact








Bookmetrix - your book and chapter metrics dashboard




